



**REACH BRITISH SCHOOL Scholarships 2020/2021**  
**(Effective August 30, 2020)**  
**Terms and Conditions**

as prepared by the, Admissions Team and Scholarship Committee

The following policies will apply to all scholarship awards awarded by Reach British School.

**This Scholarship carries a nominal fee reduction of up to 30 % of school fees only.** Student must commit to attending the school for **two** years.

**I. CRITERIA.**

All scholarship students are expected to maintain a high profile in the School, setting an example of leadership and accomplishment for other students.

- A. Academic Excellence.
- B. Uphold the values of the school.
- C. Uphold attendance of at least 95%.
- D. Taking an active role to represent the school in competitions.

**All Scholarships are awarded on the basis of:**

- o Recommendation from the Principal
- o School reports for the current year.
- o Performance in scholarship assessments.
- o Performance in 'interview' with the Principal
- o Scholarship is open for both current and new students

**II. The Scholarship ends if**

- A. Scholar leaves the school. Returning to the school at a later time does not guarantee eligibility.
- B. Is unable to behave in line with the school code of conduct.
- C. Unable to make a steady and sustained progress academically.

**III. Terms and Conditions**

1. The Scholar **commits to two full academic years at the school**, with the exception of where relocation out of the emirate/country is unavoidable with proof.
2. Students transferring to another ISP school are eligible for continuation of the scholarship at the discretionary % of the new school.
3. External Examination fees are not included in our fee structure and are not included as part of the Scholarship Programme.
4. Students who fail to meet the academic expectations will receive a letter of probation from the Admissions Team, and Scholarship Committee and will be given one semester to correct such concerns. Failure to improve academic standing within the semester of probation will result in revocation of scholarship funding, as determined by the Reach Scholarship Committee.
